Computing: Online Safety

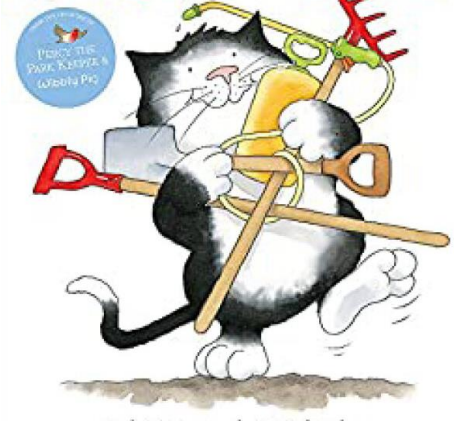
Music: 'Big Bear Funk' - learning about funk music, exploring pulse, rhythm and instruments.
